

# Orchestra Layout – What goes where?

## INSTRUCTIONS

Conductor	Stands right at the front of the orchestra
1 <sup>st</sup> Violins	Sit at the front, to the left of the <b>conductor</b>
Cellos	Sit at the front, to the right of the <b>conductor</b>
Double basses	Sit behind the <b>cellos</b> on the far right at the front
2 <sup>nd</sup> Violins	Sit on the left, just behind the 1 <sup>st</sup> <b>violins</b>
Violas	Sit on the right, in between the <b>cellos</b> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> <b>violins</b>
Flutes	Sit behind the 2 <sup>nd</sup> <b>violins</b> , next to the <b>oboes</b>
Oboes	Sit behind the <b>violas</b> , next to the <b>flutes</b>
Clarinets	Sit behind the <b>flutes</b> , in between the <b>French horns</b> and <b>bassoons</b>
Bassoons	Sit behind the <b>oboes</b> , in between the <b>clarinets</b> and <b>bassoons</b>
Trumpets	Sit behind the <b>strings</b> on the right hand side next to the <b>bassoons</b>
French horns	Sit behind the <b>strings</b> on the left hand side next to the <b>clarinets</b>
Harp	Sits at the top left hand corner of the <b>strings</b> , in front of the <b>French horns</b>
Tuba	Sits right at the back on the far right hand side, next to the <b>trombones</b>
Trombones	Sit at the back on the right, next to the <b>tuba</b>
Percussion	Right at the back on the far left hand side
Timpani	Sits at the back, in between the <b>percussion</b> and <b>trombones</b>

(Red = strings; Green = woodwinds; Blue = brass; Pink = percussion)
