HOW TO GET THERE

Meyrick Park, Bournemouth – BH2 6DY

There is no car parking at the concert site itself; but Meyrick Park lies within easy walking distance of Bournemouth Town Centre (north side). The nearest public car parks are the Pay & Display at the Town Hall on Braidley Road and the Richmond Hill Multi-Storey. There is on road parking on nearby roads around the park but please park legally and do not obstruct peoples' drives. A taxi and drop-off system will be operation on Central Drive off Braidley Road prior to the concerts. Please follow the instructions given by the traffic Marshalls. There is limited parking available for **blue badge holders** adjacent to the site, for those displaying a valid windscreen badge. *Please note this is on a first come basis.*

ADMISSION TO THE GROUNDS

Access to the concert arena is via Meyrick Park Crescent and Braidley Road. Entry via the woods is not permitted. Admission to the arena for the **Friday and Saturday concerts** is from **6pm**. **Friday's** concert starts at **8pm** and finishes at approximately **10.25pm**. **Saturday's** concert starts at **7.30pm** and finishes at approximately **9.40pm** followed by a **35-minute** fireworks, laser, lights and pyrotechnics *son et lumière* ending at about **10.30pm**. For the **Relaxed Afternoon** admission opens at **4pm** with performances starting at 4.30pm and continuing throughout until the final performance which will be from **6:30-7.15pm**.

WRISTBAND CHECKING

Your wristband is your ticket to enter the concert arena. Please ensure that it is **securely fastened before arriving at entry point**. You will only be allowed entry into the concert arena if you are wearing it on your wrist – not holding it in your hand. **No one will be admitted without a wristband. Lost wristbands cannot be replaced.** A replacement wristband must be bought at the on-the-day price. Your wristband will allow you to leave and re-enter the site if you wish.

TOILET FACILITIES

Full facilities are provided, including wide access units for wheelchair users.

MEETING POINT

The designated "Meeting Point" at the concert is the Merchandise Tent located at the rear of the arena.

USEFUL THINGS TO BRING

Picnics (including drinks and glasses), folding chairs, small tables, rugs, blankets and cushions are welcomed. Please bear in mind the outdoor nature of the concert and dress appropriately. We also advise that you bring a torch to help when packing up and when walking back to your car, as well as an umbrella in the event of rain.

WHAT IS NOT PERMITTED

It is not permitted to film the concerts or part thereof.

Please do not bring **sharp kitchen knives** for your picnics as these may be confiscated.

For fire and safety precautions, **wax torches, oil and paraffin lamps, butane gas lamps, sparklers, fires and barbeques** are not permitted. Only enclosed candles and tea lights are allowed.

For the convenience and safety of everyone **marquees, gazebos, windbreaks, tents and large sunshades** are not permitted due to the unpredictable nature of British weather.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ADDITIONAL SECURITY MEASURES WILL BE IN OPERATION, INCLUDING RANDOM BAG AND PAT DOWN SEARCHES.

NO DOGS can be admitted except Guide Dogs. However please remember that there will be loud bangs during the fireworks.

CANCELLATION and BAD WEATHER

In exceptional circumstances the concert may be cancelled. However the decision to cancel will not be made until the advertised start time. In the event of inclement weather the concert **will** take place, but the programme may be modified in the interests of safety and comfort.

CONSIDERATION FOR OTHERS

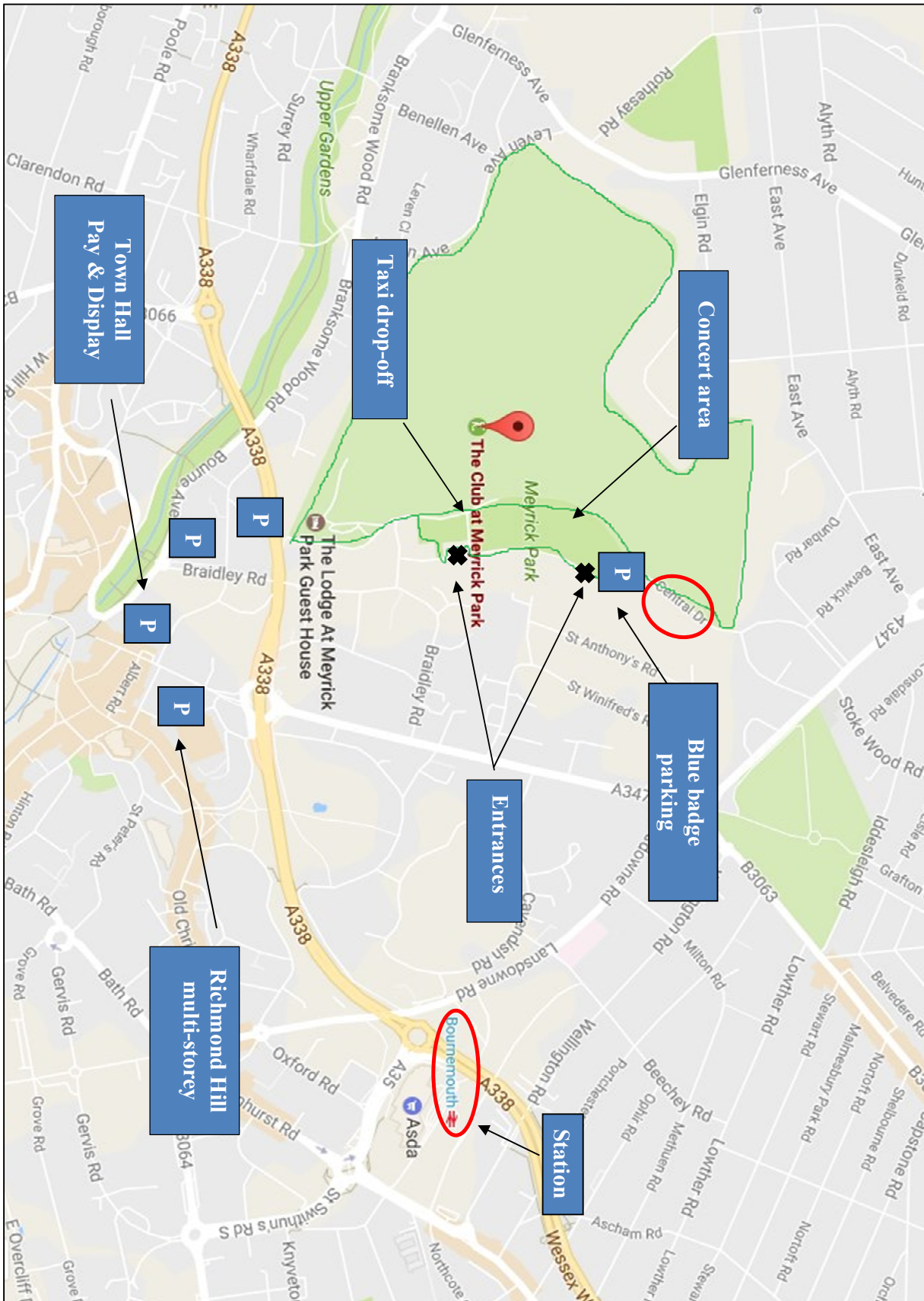
The concert arena will be a **NO SMOKING** area. Designated smoking areas will be available. Please turn mobile phones to silent and don't let children play unsupervised.
