

Nikolai Rimsky-Korsakov's Scheherazade, Movement 1

This symphonic suite, composed in 1888, is based on *One Thousand and One Nights*; a collection of Middle Eastern folk tales. In the concert, you will hear the first movement called *The Sea and Sinbad's Ship*. Sinbad is a heroic character, who sails the sea and has fantastic adventures featuring magical realms and terrifying or mystical creatures.
